The only way that you will eventually and hopefully understand that, is to ask God to help you break away from all the distractions of this world. When you really examine all the different distractions from entertainment in the world today, all they really are is man's folly and his foolish wisdom inspired by the devil himself. This foolish wisdom, is Satin's way of distracting us from the word of God. The Lord speaks about man's foolish wisdom in 1 Corinthians 3 :19-20
