

This month, I am going to try and help you to understand through God's sacred scriptures, the importance of daily reverent prayers to the Lord. Before the Lord taught me about the importance of reverent prayer, I use to wake up every morning with all kinds of anxiety, fears, guilt, and confusion. I did not know which end was up at times.
