

THE GOOD SHEPHERD

The word shepherd in a practical sense, means one who tends sheep, or is a guardian of his flock. The word shepherd is derived from the Hebrew word meaning, "to pasture or tend". In the Old testament in Jeremiah 31:10 the Lord says: Hear the word of the Lord, O nations; proclaim it in distant coastlands: He who scattered Israel will gather them and will watch over His flock like a shepherd. In Ezekiel 34:12 the Lord says: As a shepherd looks after his scattered flock when he is with them, so will I look after My sheep. I will rescue them from all places where they were scattered on a day of clouds and darkness. In the psalms of David, one of my favorite scriptures about my Shepherd is Psalm 23:1-4 when David said, The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.

He makes me lie down in green pastures, He leads me beside quiet waters, He restores my soul. He guides me in the path of righteousness for His name sake. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and staff, they comfort me.

These Old testament scriptures should confirm the fact that, even in the old days before Jesus, our Heavenly Father, was our **original Good Shepherd**.

Moving forward in time to the New Testament, Our Father up above, clearly reminds us through His words of wisdom, that Jesus Christ, is our Good Shepherd. When I say good shepherd, I mean just that. He is one who will never leave you or forsake you. In the book of John chapter 10, Jesus clarifies that He is the Good Shepherd. The Lord says in verse 1-2 "I tell you the truth, the man who does not enter the sheep pen by the gate, but climbs in by some other way, is a thief and a robber. The man who enters by the gate is the shepherd of his sheep.

Jesus goes on to say in verse 3-5 The watchman opens the gate for him, and the sheep listen to his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has brought out all his own, He goes on ahead of them, and his sheep follow him because they know his voice. But they will never follow a stranger; in fact, they will run away from him because they do not recognize his voice".

What is the Lord trying to tell us in that scripture? What does He mean when He says His sheep follow Him because they know His voice? Also, what does the Lord mean when He says that they will never follow a stranger, in fact they will run away?

In order to fully understand what God is trying to tell us in this scriptures, you must be part of His flock. Being part of His flock, means that we must come to the end of our flesh. For there is no understanding of God's word, while living by our flesh.

Coming to the end of our flesh means, instead of depending on our sinful nature, we depend totally on God's eternal nature. Without having a good shepherd guiding us daily, we seem to fall prey to sin automatically. Every bad choice we make has consequences, some more serious than others. Some bad choices, can even lead to death. Death not only on the body, but also the death of the soul! The problem with people who don't have the Lord as their good shepherd, is the fact that they believe in there secular minds that they have everything under their control and their control alone. That way of thinking, is the reason why there is so much darkness in the world today.

As a born again believer in the Lord, you automatically avoid doing what the world wants you to do. As the scripture says, we don't recognize the voice of the world.

We don't follow the worlds ways. We even run away from it, because we know it is not coming from our Good Shepherd.
