

PEACE ON EARTH

Lord we thank You and praise You in Jesus name. This month's inspired message has to do with peace in the world. First of all, what is the meaning of peace? There are several meanings for the word peace. Peace is a state of calm and quiet. Peace is freedom from disturbing thoughts or emotions. Peace is a state of concord (as between persons or government). Also, peace is an agreement to end hostilities. In this sinful, dark and godless world we live in, it is no wonder that peace is so hard to find and maintain. The world we live in with all it's destructive ways, can not and will not ever give us any lasting peace. Over 2,000 years ago in a little town called Bethlehem, the Savior of the world was born. His named was Jesus. The Bible tells us that they will call Him Immanuel, which means, "God with us." Why is there so much controversy over one's man birth? I will tell you why, because Satin and this world that we live in, will do everything in it's power to keep mankind from knowing the truth and true meaning of the birth of Christ Jesus. In the Bible, the birth of Christ can be found in Matthew 1:18-25 and also in Luke 2:1-20. The Bible tells us that, unlike any other baby that was ever born on this earth, the One born in Bethlehem that night was unique in all of history. He was not created by a human father or mother. Jesus had a heavenly pre-existence. This Divine information can be found in the book of John 1:1-3, 14. He is God, the Son—Creator of the universe. Philippians 2:5-11. This is why Christmas is called the incarnation, the union of divine and human natures in Jesus Christ. (Galatians 4:4; Luke 2:7; John 1:46; Hebrews 2:9). Jesus did not come as a powerful king or a superman; He came as a baby dependent on others for His physical care. What was the main reason, that Jesus came in the first place? Christ came to earth exclusively to be a sacrificial lamb for the sins of the world. (John 1:29) Throughout His life, Jesus lived under very humble circumstances- virtually no possessions, no physical wealth, and often dependent on others for food, drink and clothing. The fact that He was God the Son, why did He live such a humble life? There are four more basic reasons why Jesus had to come into this world in such humble circumstances

- 1. To execute the purpose of God (Acts 2:23,24; Psalms 40:6-8)
- 2. To fulfill the Old Testament types and prophecies.
- 3. To satisfy the law, paying for the guilty (Isaiah 53; Hebrews 9:12,15), and obtaining for them eternal redemption.
- 4. To show all us sinners an example of how to live our lives.

God the Father knew exactly what He was doing, when He sent His one and only Son Jesus down to earth. From a born again believers perspective, God's true purpose for the birth of Christ Jesus, was absolutely perfect and precise, without any flaws. Satin's master plan of spiritual destruction was foiled, when Christ was born. This was the actual beginning of the end for Satin. Even though he still prowls around devouring souls daily, his end is in site. There are a bunch of devil followers out there, working real hard to take Christ out of Christmas. The way the world has been headed lately, it is no surprise to me. I believe that it is a sacrilege to say the least, what these demons are trying to do to the true meaning of Christmas in this country!
