### **GOD'S SPIRITUAL DISCERNMENT**

Lord may we all comfort our brothers and sisters in times of doubts and fears. Father, please give us Your strength to survive in this evil world we live in. Lord please keep us focused on our Eternal Victory in Christ. Father I ask all this in the name of Your Son and our Savior Jesus Christ......Amen This month I would like to talk about some of the steps needed for spiritual growth. Also, about the gift of God's Spiritual Discernment.

As we continue to grow in our faith, the Lord shows us so many different things that we all need to know about His Divine Word. When it comes to growing in the word of the Lord, it first takes a sincere commitment to change the way we think and live. When I speak about a sincere commitment to change, I mean we must stop thinking and acting worldly, and start to think and act Godly.

How can we as worldly living people, change our evil ways? First, we must sincerely want to change our fleshly ways. Second, we must go in prayer to our Abba Father and ask for His forgiveness for all our sins. From that point on, we both embraced each others hands and then preceded slowly towards the kitchen. My wife found the gas candle lighter first. She then preceded over to other side of the kitchen and help me to find the flashlight and from that point on, everything looked hopeful. Then, we both preceded to light candles in several other rooms in the house to try to make our home look as normal as it could look, under these unforeseen conditions. At that moment a sense of renewed hope was restore from within. We both then looked at each other and started to laugh a little. But deep inside, we both breathed a sigh of relief, that we finally found some light, in this sudden darkness. The reason why the Spirit put this illustration on my heart to share with this ministry this month, was to remind us all of the spiritual darkness that is all around us in this sinful world that we live in. Try and always remember, that in the beginning of the creation of the world God is the originator of light.

In Genesis 1:3 the Lord said, <u>And God said</u>, <u>"Let there be light," and there</u> was light.

## With respect to God's light in Proverbs 4:18 it is written <u>The path of the</u> <u>righteous is like the first gleam of dawn, shinning ever brighter till the</u> <u>full light of day.</u>

According to that scripture, once we start to walk in God's Righteousness, there is no darkness.
