One would think that it has exclusively to do with sexual fornication, but let me tell you my friends, is comes in many other shapes and sizes. Lust is anything that is in direct opposite to God's will. Lust is a fleshly desire that burns from within our souls, if left unchecked, it will bring us down and destroy our living souls. Lust always starts out slow and innocent, until it gets into our soul. From that point on, it starts growing with unbridled passion until there is no stopping it. Having a desire or a need for something, is not the same as having a lust for something. In order to get a better perspective on this subject, lets break it into these main subjects. Lust for money. According to the Bible, it is the seduction from spiritual demons that we can not see or touch, that seductively lure us into their destructive path. Paul warns us all in Ephesians 6:12 that For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Some people might say, I can't help myself, God made us this way. That statement is only a cop out, reason being, it's just an excuse to justify our perverse minds and sinful natures. Another good line is, it's okay because these lustful desires make me feel good inside and whatever feels good inside, has got to be good. There are numerous excuses used by all of us from time to time, to justify our sinful nature. These secular ways of thinking, are only stumbling blocks that can blind us from God's plan for us. Before Jesus, I had no purpose in my life at that time, but to satisfy my lustful desires.

After Jesus, instead of wanting to satisfy my lustful desires, I now have a compelling desire to satisfy the Lord, first and foremost. When you pass through darkness into God's light, at that point, there is a compelling desire to refrain from lustful desires?

Because once we start living in the light of God's peace, there is no turning back. Once we taste and see the goodness of the Lord, it can be very addicting. Why does it become so addicting? God will give us wisdom and courage. He will surround us with brothers and sisters in Christ to help carry our burdens, and even provide us with insight and practical assistance.


