GOD VS THE DEVIL

Dear Heavenly Father, we come before You to give you thanks and praise for all the blessings that you have for those who trust in You. Father we bless Your Holy Name, we thank You for Your free gift of Eternal Salvation in Your Son, Christ Jesus. Father, help us all stay close to Your Words of Divine Wisdom. Lord, please continue to help us all put on Your Armor of Righteousness against the attacks of the devil's lies and deceptions. Father we ask this in Jesus name.....Amen. This month the Holy Spirit has inspired me to talk about spiritual protection. What is spiritual protection? Spiritual protection is, God's Armor of Righteousness. In Ephesians 6:10-17 it is written: Put on the full armor of God so that you can stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand, and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

In the Christian life we battle against rulers and authorities. They are the powerful evil forces of fallen angels headed by Satin, who is a vicious fighter. To withstand their attacks, we must depend on God's strength and every piece of His armor. 1Peter 5:8 tells us; Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. These who are not "flesh and blood" are demons over whom Satin has control. They are not mere fantasies—they are very real. We face a powerful army whose goal is to defeat Christ church. When we believe in Christ Jesus, these beings become our enemies, they try every devise to turn us away from Him and back to sin. Although we are assured of victory, we must engage in the struggle until Christ returns, because Satin is constantly battling on all who are on the Lord's side. We need supernatural power to defeat Satin, and God has provided this by giving us His Holy Spirit within us

and His Armor surrounding us. Satin fights with lies, and sometimes his lies sound like truths; but only believers have God's truth, which can defeat Satin's lies.

The devil often attacks our heart—the seat of our emotions, self worth and trust. God's righteousness is the breastplate that protects our heart and ensures His approval. He approves of us because He loves us and sent His Son to die for us.

Satin wants us to think that telling others the Good News is a worthless and hopeless task—the size of the task is too big and the negative responses are too much to handle. But the footgear God gives us is the motivation to continue to proclaim the true peace that is available in God—news that everyone needs to hear.

What we see are Satins attacks in the form of insults, setbacks and temptations. But the shield of faith protects us from Satin's flaming arrows. With God's perspective, we can see beyond our circumstances and know that ultimate victory is ours.

Satin wants us to doubt God, Jesus and our salvation. The helmet protects our mind from God's saving work for us.

The sword of armor is a weapon of offense. There are times when we need to take the offensive against Satin. When we are tempted, we need to trust in the truth of God's word. Prayer is one of the most effective ways to show our trust in the word of the Lord. By praying for the strength to overcome the devils temptations, lies and deceptions, we let God know that we believe in His power to overcome the forces of evil. At that time the Lord unleashes our protective armor rendering Satins plan of spiritual destruction powerless and ineffective.

Try and never forget the fact that Satin ("the tempter") is the most powerful of all the evil spirits. His power can affect both the spiritual world (Ephesians 2:1-3; 6:10-12) and the physical world.

(2 Corinthians 12:7-12) Satin even tempted Jesus. (Matthew 4:1-11) But Jesus defeated Satin when He died on the cross for our sins and rose again to give us a new life. At the proper time God will overthrow Satin forever. Revelation 20:1-3 it is written: An I saw the angel coming down from heaven, having the key to the abyss and holding in his hand a great chain. He seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is the devil, or Satin, and bound him for a thousand years. He threw him into the abyss, and locked and sealed it over him, to keep him from deceiving the nations anymore until the thousand years were ended. After that, he must be set free for a short time. In Revelation 20:7-10 the Lord goes on to explain Satin's final doom: When the thousand years are over,

Satin will be released from his prison and will go out to deceive the nations in the four corners of the earth—Gog and Magog - to gather them for battle. In number they are like the sands on the seashore. They marched across the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of God's people, the city He loves. But fire came down from heaven and devoured them. And the devil who deceived them, was thrown into the lake of burning sulfur, where the beast and the false prophet had been thrown. They will be tormented day and night forever and ever. So my brothers and sisters in the Lord Christ Jesus, always try and remember that beneath the surface of routine daily life, a fierce struggle among invisible spiritual powers is being waged. Our main defense is prayer that God will protect us from the evil one and that He will strengthen us. Concerning our armor of spiritual warfare, the following guidelines can help us prepare for and survive satanic attacks: (1) Take the threat of spiritual attack seriously. (2) Pray for strength and help from God. (3) Study the Bible to recognize Satin's style and tactics. (4) Memorize Scripture so it will be a source of help no matter where you are. (5) Associate yourself with those who speak the truth. (6) Practice what you are taught by sound spiritual leaders. In closing, it is my hope that these teachings will help us all to be more aware and alert to the evil one's lies and deceptions. May we all pray and ask God to help us with theses daily struggles. Also, may we ask Him for His forgiveness of our daily sins in Jesus name.....Amen.
