

OUR TRUE IDENTITY IN CHRIST

Amen. This month's inspired message has to do with Our True Identity in Christ. When I say our true identity in Christ, what am I really trying to say? Identity has to do with a sameness of essential character, individuality, or the fact of being the same person or thing as claimed. God wants all His children to model ourselves in a oneness with Jesus. When someone gives you a gift, do you say, "That's really nice—how much do I owe you? No, the appropriate response to a gift is, "Thank You." Yet how often Christians after they have been given the gift of salvation, feel obligated to try to work their way to God. Because our salvation even our faith are gifts, we should respond with gratitude, praise and joy. We become Christians through God's unmerited grace, not as the results of any effort, ability, intelligent choice, or act of service on our part. However, out of gratitude for this free gift, we will seek to help and serve others with kindness, love, gentleness, and not merely to please ourselves. While no action or work we can do can help us obtain salvation, God's intention is that our salvation will result in acts of service. We are not saved merely for our own benefit but to serve Christ and build up His Church. We are God's workmanship (work of art, masterpiece). Our salvation is something only God can do. It is His powerful creative work in us. If God considers us His works of art, we dare not treat ourselves or others with disrespect or as inferior work. Through faith in Christ, we stand acquitted, or not guilty, before God. The Lord says in Romans 3:21,22 But now a righteousness from God, apart from law, has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify. This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. God does not take us out of the world or make us robots—we still feel like sinning, and sometimes we will sin. The difference is that before we became Christians, we were dead in our sins and were slaves to our sinful nature. But now we have both our true identity and are alive in Christ all at once.

Our true Identity in Christ has numerous benefits to draw upon. Things like; We are justified (declared "not guilty" of sin). No condemnation awaits us.
