WHY WORRY By Evangelist Dennis A. Palma

This month, the Holy Spirit has touched my heart to talk to this ministry about worry. Worry is kind of a subject that we can talk about until our hair turns blue and still not truly understand it. Why are people so affected by its deadly venom? Reason being, worry comes directly from the devil, not God. Why is worry so contagious? Because, once we give worry a place to grow, it can escalate real fast. So fast that it can spread faster then a ragging fire! Worry actually got its roots from original sin. As it is written, original sin can be traced back through the Bible to Adam and Eve. Before sin entered into the world through Adam and Eve, fear and worry did not exist! Adam and Eve had a worry free life in the beginning, but gave it all up for sin! Where there is no fear, there is no worry! Jesus commands us not to worry! How can we avoid worry? Only faith can free us from the anxieties caused by fear and worry. Working and planning responsibly are good; dwelling on all the ways our planning could go wrong is bad. Worry is pointless because it can't fill any of our needs; worry is foolish because the Creator of the universe loves us and knows what we need. He promises to meet all our needs, but not necessarily our desires. Overcoming worry requires: (1) Simply trust in God, our heavenly Father. This trust is expressed by *praying to Him rather than worrying*. (2) Perspective on your problems. This can be gained by developing a strategy for addressing and correcting your problem. (3) A support team would be beneficial to help. Find some believers who will pray for you to find the wisdom and strength to deal with your worries. Seeking the Kingdom of God above all else means making Jesus the Lord

and King of our lives. In order to free ourselves from this debilitating decease, we must let Him control every area of our life- our work, our play,


our plans and our relationships. Is the kingdom only one of your many concerns, or is it central to all you do? Are you holding back any areas of your life from God's control? As Lord and Creator, He wants to help provide what we need as well as guide us how we use what He provides. In **Philippians 4:6-7** God says: <u>And my God will meet all your needs</u> according to His glorious riches in Christ Jesus.

The Lord also says in Isaiah 32:17 that: The fruit of righteousness will be peace; the effect of righteousness will be quietness and confidence forever. God acts from above to change man's condition here on earth. Only when God's Spirit is among us can we achieve true peace and fruitfulness. When we are following our own will and not doing God's, we leave ourselves open and venerable for the devil attacks, just like Adam and Eve did! Satan only needs a little doubt to get us to start worrying. Once doubt gets a foot in the door, is when fear and worry start to grow. Once we start to allow doubt, fear, and worry to become important, is when we make worry our god! The Bible tells us that, God gets real sad and disappointed when we allow sin and worry to become more important then Him. God loves us so much that whenever we start to fall into that dark hole of worry. He left us with numerous scriptures in the Bible, to help restore us from worry, back to a sense of peacefulness! A kind of peace that surpasses all of mans understanding. The Lord gives us a sense, that everything is going to be all right, and that God is in control of our worry, not us. Some of my favorite scriptures that have a calming effect about worry can be found in **Psalm 46:1-3.** The Lord said that: God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam and the mountain quake with their surging. Another one of my favorites can be found in Jeremiah 17:8. The Lord also said: "He will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit. Furthermore it is written in Philippians 46:1-3 Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard our hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

All three scriptures, the Lord has blessed me with, to help me combat my own personal fears and worries. I know that it's true for me because, every time I took my eyes off of Jesus, I myself not God, let worry into my life. I know from years of walking with the Lord, that peace instead of worry, are only a prayer away, thanks to the Lord Christ Jesus!

When I look back in time with respect to my own personal struggles, I did not have a clue for a long time! But as my personal relationship with God started to grow stronger, the Lord began to teach me a lot of painful lessons about the need to stay real close to Him or else. Most people get turn off when it comes to mandates. Reason being, is the fact that we want to control ourselves, not God! For me personally, I use to think that I was in control of myself, till one day God started to show me the difference. He made me see through years of my own prideful control, that I really don't have no control, at all! The only real control we have in life, is our personal choices we make. We can either have peace by following the Lord Christ Jesus, or continue to have doubt, worry and fear by following ourselves!!!

So my brothers and sisters in the Lord Christ Jesus, it is my hope that this month's inspired message will help us to better understand what it takes to deal with our fears and worries. May we all ask God to help us find His Peace for our souls, through these times of darkness and uncertainties!
