THE SANCTITY OF MARRIAGE

Father, please teach us how to better serve You Lord in everything we do. Father, I ask this prayer in the name of our Shepherd and Savior, Christ JesusAmen! This month, the Holy Spirit has inspired me to talk about the sanctity of marriage. Why the sanctity of marriage? Because marriage between a man and a woman, has been reinvented by man from God's original purpose. Marriage throughout the Old and the New Testament has always been designed by God, not man! The trouble is, marriage has been portrayed by our society with stories of sexual escapades, secret rendezvous, and extra marital affairs. Today's media teach that immorality means freedom, perversion is natural, and commitment is old fashion. Sex, created by God and pronounced good in Eden, has been twisted, exploited, and has turned into an urgent, illicit, casual, and self gratifying activity. Love has turned into lust, giving into getting, and lasting commitment into "no strings attached! In reality, sexual intercourse, the physical and emotional union of male and female, should be a holy means of celebrating love, producing children, and experiencing pleasure, protected by the commitment of marriage. God thinks sex is important, and scripture contains numerous guidelines for its use and warnings about its misuse. And sex is always mentioned in the context of a loving relationship between husband and wife. The power of love requires more than the language of feeling to protect it. Sexual expression is such an integral part of our selfhood, that we need the boundary of marriage to safeguard our love. Marriage is a celebration of a daily commitment between a husband and a wife. Because love is such a powerful expression of feeling and commitment between a man and women, it is not to be regarded casually. According to

God, we are not to manipulate others into loving us, and love should not be prematurely encouraged in a relationship.

While romance keeps a marriage interesting, commitment keeps romance from dwindling away. Our love for someone makes him or her appear beautiful to us. As you consider marriage, don't just look at the physical attractiveness in a person. Try and look first at the inner qualities that don't fade with time--spiritual commitment, integrity, sensitivity, and sincerity. The decision to commit yourself to your spouse alone begins at the marriage altar between a man, a women, and God! There are no exceptions to God's Will. However, the Gay society would like you to believe, that same sex marriage is okay! It is amazing to say the least, how the devil always manages to deceive God's people. Satan has the Gay community believing that sex and marriage is okay between a man and a man, or, a women and a women. Believe you me, if God had originally intended for a man or a women to have the same partners, He would have created Adam and Steve and not Adam and Eve! Amen. 26 Because of this, God gave them over to shameful lust. Even their woman exchanged natural relationships for unnatural ones. 27 In the same way men also abandoned natural relations with woman and were inflamed with lust for one another. Men committed indecent acts with other men, and received in themselves the due penalty for their

perversion. 28 Furthermore, since they did not think it worthwhile to retain the knowledge of God, He gave them over to a depraved mind, to do what ought not to be done.

Please try and remember, that God loves gay people the same way He loves all His people! The only thing that He really hates is sin. Sin in reality, is direct defiance against the Will of God. God's Will, is clearly written in the Bible for all of God's people to read. There will be no excuses that can help us in the end! God's wrath and eternal destruction will come upon all who hate God and are defiant and disrespectful to His Will!!!!

In closing, here are some final thoughts to help you further understand the Sanctity of Marriage. Please note that inevitably with the passing of time and the growth of familiarity, a marriage will tend to loose its initial sparkle. Glances and touches no longer produce the same emotional response. Conflicts and pressures may creep in, causing you to lose your tenderness towards your spouse.
