THE LAMB OF GOD By Evangelist Dennis A. Palma

Almighty Father above, may we all give you thanks, praise, and bless You Lord, for the birth of Your Son and our Savior Jesus Christ. May we rejoice in His promise of eternal life, through Him, and with Him, for Eternity. Father, please help us to repent of our sins and live each day in Your Divine Presence. Lord, may the Light of Jesus shine upon all His people to be more caring, sharing, and giving to the poor and less fortunate this Christmas. Father, please teach us the real meaning of Christmas and help us to refrain from secularism. Lord we thank You again for being our ever present Light in the night. Father I ask this prayer in Christ Jesus name, Hallelujah, Amen! The Holy Spirit has inspired me this month, to talk about the Lamb of God. Who is the Lamb of God? The Lamb of God is Jesus Christ, our Savior! Jesus' earthly history begins in the town of Bethlehem in the Roman providence of Judea. A threat to kill the infant King led Joseph and Mary to take their family to Egypt to avoid these threats. After the danger had past, God led them to settle in Nazareth in Galilee. From His childhood home in Nazareth, at age 30, Jesus set out to set up His earthly ministry. Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist in the Jordan River and was tempted by Satan in the Judean Desert. Jesus set up His base of operation in Capernaum and from there He ministered throughout Israel, telling parables, teaching about the Kingdom and healing the sick. He traveled to the region of the Gadarenes around Gadera and healed demon-possessed men. He fed over 5,000 people with 5 loaves and 2 fishes on the shores of Galilee near Bethsaida. He healed the sick in Gennesaret. He ministered to the Gentiles in Tyre, Sidon, and visited Caesarea Phillipi where Peter declared Jesus to be the Messiah. He also taught in Perea east of the Jordan. As He set out on His last visit to Jerusalem, Jesus told the Disciples what would happen to Him there. He spent some time in Jericho and then stayed in Bethany at night as He went back and forth to Jerusalem during His last week before His Death. In Jerusalem, Jesus was crucified, suffer, and die on the cross. But God's Plan was that He would rise again to save us all from eternal damnation. In the Bible Jesus is revealed as, the King of kings and for His miraculous birth, and for His life, and teachings. Also, for His miracles and triumph over death, and true identity. Jesus cannot be equated with any person or power. He is the supreme ruler of time and eternity, heaven and earth, humans and angels. So Lets give Him His rightful place as King of our lives! Jesus is the Messiah, the one for whom the Jews had waited to deliver them from Roman oppression. Yet, tragically, they did not recognize Him when He came because His kingship was not what they had expected. The true purpose for God's anointed deliverer was to die for all people to free them from sin's oppression. Jesus is, the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. Because Jesus was sent from God, we can trust Him with our lives. It is worth everything we have to acknowledge Him and give ourselves to Him, because He came to be our Messiah and our Savior.

Jesus came to earth to begin His Kingdom. His full Kingdom will be realized at His return and will be made up of anyone who has faithfully followed Him. The way to enter God's Kingdom is by faith- believing in Jesus to save us from sin and change our lives. We must do the work of His Kingdom now to be prepared for His return.

Jesus taught the people through sermons, illustrations, and parables. Through His teachings, He showed the true ingredients of faith and how to guard against a fruitless and hypocritical life. Jesus teachings showed us how to prepare for life in His Eternal Kingdom, by living properly right now. He lived what He taught and we, too, must practice what we preach. When Jesus rose from the dead, He rose in power as the true King. In His victory over death, He established His credentials as King and His power and authority over evil. Also, the resurrection shows Jesus' all-powerful life for us-not even death could stop His plan of offering eternal life. Those who believe in Jesus can hope for a resurrection like His. Our role as Christians is to tell His story to all the earth so that everyone can share in His victory. Another important note about Jesus is that He is both God and human. The Infinite, Unlimited God, took on the limitations of humanity. The reason why He is the Lamb of God is the fact that the God of the Bible tells us so. In John 1:29 the Lord said: The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world." Try to understand that Jesus was a predestined sacrifice for all our sins, not only for the sins of the past, but also for all the sins of the present and the future as well. Also, the Lamb of God is the Lamb of Love according to the scripture. In John 3:16 the Lord says: "For God so loved the world that he gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have Eternal Life."
