As we approach the celebration of Easter this month, I like to take this time to reflect on the death and resurrection of our Savior. Christ Jesus. No other time in the history of the world, except for the birth of Christ, has anything been so eventful as the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Why is the death and resurrection of Christ Jesus so profoundly important? Because of the death and resurrection of Christ, we have all been given an opportunity to receive the free gift of eternal salvation. According to the Bible, whoever truly believes in Christ sacrifice on the cross for our sins, has been blessed with the gift of eternal salvation. Also thanks to Jesus, the bondage of sin has been broken. Furthermore, the Bible tells us that Jesus Christ is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world! Forgiveness was granted in the Old Testament on the basis of the shedding of animals' blood. In Leviticus 17:11 it is written; For the life of a creature is in the blood, an I have given it to you to make atonement for yourselves on the altar; it is the blood that makes atonement for one's life.

Now sin is forgiven on the basis of the shedding of Jesus' blood—He died as the perfect and final sacrifice for our sins. In **Ephesians 2:13** God says;

But now in Christ Jesus you who were once far away have been

brought near through the blood of Christ. Why does forgiveness require the shedding of blood? This is no arbitrary decree on the part of a blood thirsty God, as some have suggested. There is no greater symbol of life than blood; blood keeps us alive. Jesus shed His blood, gave His life—for our sins so that we would not have to experience spiritual death, being eternally separated from God. Jesus is the source of life, not death. He gave His own life to pay our penalty for us so that we might live. After shedding His blood for us, Christ rose from the grave and proclaimed victory over sin and death. Jesus has the power over Life as well as the power to forgive sins. That is because He is the Creator of life. Jesus tells us in John 14:6 <u>"I am the Way and the Truth and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through</u> <u>Me.</u> He who is Life can surely restore Life. Whoever believes in Christ has a spiritual life that death cannot conquer or diminish in any way.

When we finally realize His Power and how wonderful His offer to us really is, how can we help but commit our lives to Him! To those of us who believe, what wonderful assurance and certainty we have: "Because I live, you also will live". In John 14:19 Jesus said: Before long, the world will not see Me anymore, but you will see Me. Because I live, you also will live. What was Jesus trying to tell us in this scripture when He said; before long, the world will not see Me anymore, but you will see Me? Jesus was referring to not seeing His Physical Presence on earth anymore. But when He said that you will see Me again, He was talking about seeing Him in His spiritual sense, His Holy Spirit. When we continue to trust in our flesh and not Christ Jesus, we are making a big mistake. For without the Holy Spirit's Divine Indwelling in us, we are on the road for failure. Without the Indwelling of the Holy Spirit, we become a target for attacks from Satan and his league of demons. Also, without the covering of God's full Armor of Righteousness, we don't stand a chance! In closing here are a few more things to focus on. No other religious teacher could die for our sins; no other religious teacher came to earth as God's only Son; no other teacher rose from the dead! Our focus at this time should be on what God offers us, as a way to have an eternal relationship with Him. So my brothers and sisters in the Lord Jesus Christ, please try and remember the true purpose of Jesus' first mission on earth. It was not to judge people, but to show us all, the way to find salvation and eternal life!!! Hallelujah, Praise the Lord Jesus Christ.....Amen.
