

God also tells us in 2 Peter 1:19; And we have heard the words of the prophets made more certain, and you will do well to pay attention to it, as a shinning light in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts. Christ is our "Morning Star," and when He returns, He will shine in His full glory. Until that day, we have Scripture as our guiding Light.
