How easy is it to debate what a passage means and not live out that meaning? Are you content in any circumstance you face? Paul knew how to be content when he had plenty or whether he was in need. The secret why Paul was so content was the fact that he was drawing on Christ Power for strength alone, and not his own. Do you at this time have great needs, or are you discontented because you don't have what you want or desire? Secret to deal with this problem is to learn to rely on God's promises and ask God to remove that desire and teach you contentment in all circumstances. He will supply all our needs, in a way that only He knows what's best for us. If we believe in our heart and trust God, He will always meet our needs. Whatever we need on earth, He will always supply our needs, even if it's the courage to face death as Paul did. Also, whatever we need in heaven He will supply. We must remember, however, the difference between our wants and our needs. Most people want to feel good and avoid discomfort or pain. We may not always get what we want! But by trusting in Christ, our attitudes and appetites can change from wanting everything to accepting His provision and power to live for Him. Let us pray: Abba Father, Lord Jesus, and the Holy Spirit, thank You Father for Your Inspired message this month. May this message, touch the hearts and minds of Your people. Lord, may we all find peace in Your Words of Divine Wisdom. Also Father, please continue to watch over and protect us, with Your Holy Spirit's, full Armor of Divine Righteousness.
