Hello again my brothers and sisters, welcome to the Spiritual Connection's Monthly Journal for March 2015. This month's inspired message has to do with God's Forgiveness! Let us begin In Matthew 6:14; Jesus said; For if we forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. In this Scripture, Jesus gives us a startling warning about forgiveness. If we refuse to forgive others, God will also refuse to forgive us. Why? The reason why is because when we don't forgive others, we are denying our common ground as sinners in need of God's forgiveness. God's forgiveness of sin is not the direct result of us forgiving others, but it is the base on our realizing what forgiveness means. It is easy to ask God for forgiveness, but difficult to forgive others. Whenever we ask God to forgive our sins, we should ask ourselves, "Have I forgiven the people who have wronged me?" If we are looking for God's forgiveness, but not looking to forgive others, we are hypocrites in the Eyes of the Lord. In Ephesians 4:32 God tells us to; Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. This is Christ's law and command as taught in the Gospels. Also, Mark 11:25 the Lord tells us; And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive him, so your Father in heaven will forgive your sins. Forgiving others is tough work---so much that many people would like to do something totally distasteful then offer forgiveness to someone who has wronged them. For a person to pray while bearing a grudge, however, is like a tree sprouting leaves but bearing no fruit.

True faith changes our hearts. Real prayer dismantles pride and vengeance, filling the empty holes with God's Love. Real faith, seeks God's Peace! For our churches to have prayer power there must be harmony and forgiveness, evident in the body of believers. God tells us to let go of hurts, abandon grudges, and forgive others. Jesus tells us in the Lord's Prayer----"Forgive us our debts, as we have forgiven our debtors" When Jesus taught His disciples to pray He made forgiveness the cornerstone with their relationship with God. God has forgiven our sins; we must now forgive those who have wronged us. To remain unforgiving, means that we have not understood that we ourselves deeply need to be forgiven. Take a minute at this time and try to think about those who have wronged you. My question to you would be, have you forgiven them? How will God treat you if He treats you as you treat others? However, God does not forgive us just because we forgive others, because, this is just one of the requirements needed for God's undeserving Forgiveness. However, God forgives us solely because of His great Love and Mercy. As we come to understand His Mercy, however, we will want to be just like Him. Having received forgiveness, we will want to pass it on to others. God's Mercy has to be coupled with our forgiveness for those who have wronged us in order to be truly forgiven! Those who are unwilling to forgive, have not become one with Christ, who was willing to forgive even those who crucified Him. Last thought! In order to avoid holding a grudge against someone who has wronged you, the Lord tells us in Luke 6: 35-38; But love your enemies, do good to them, and lend to them without expecting to get anything back. Then your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High, because He is kind to the ungrateful and wicked. Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful. "Do not judge and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. Give and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured in your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you. My brothers and sisters, a forgiving spirit demonstrates that a person has

received God's Forgiveness. If we are critical rather than compassionate, we will also receive criticism. If we treat others generously, graciously, and compassionately, however, these qualities will come back to us in full measure!! Let us pray, Abba Father, Lord Jesus, and the Holy Spirit, may we pray at this time that Your Holy Spirit, guide us, protect us, and direct us. Father, please help us to see clearly our need for forgiveness to others.

Father God, we all are sinners in need of Your Forgiveness. Lord, please help us to forgive others who have sinned against us. Father, please help us to forgive others as You have forgiven us. Lord, please open up our hearts and minds to the blessings and peace that comes to those who forgive. Father, I ask this in Jesus name......Amen!!
