THE TRUTH WILL SET YOU FREE By Evangelist Dennis A. Palma

Dear Abba Father, Lord Jesus, and the Holy Spirit, we thank You, praise You, and bless You Lord, for another inspirational message this month. Father, please enlighten us to better understand the reality of Your Divine Truth. Lord, may our hearts and minds gravitate to Your Living Holy Word, the Bible! Lord, please help us to avoid the pitfalls of secularism. Father, please help us to rise above Satan's forces of evil, that dominate this world. Lord Jesus, may Your Eternal Light cleanse this world of sin and darkness. Father, please teach us how to prepare our souls for the final victory in Christ Jesus. Lord, I ask this prayer in Jesus name. Hallelujah! Amen!!

This month's inspired message from the Holy Spirit, has to do with God's Truth. God's Truth, can only be found in God's Living Word, the Holy Bible. Most people hate to hear the word, Bible! Others find freedom, from the chains of bondage from sin. The Bible is not a collection of stories, fables, myths or merely human ideas about God, it is the Truth that sets us free! Through God's Holy Spirit, the Lord revealed His person and plan to certain believers, who wrote down His inspired message for His people. It is written in 2 Peter 1:20, 21; Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation. For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit. "Men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit" means that Scripture did not come from the prophet's own invention or interpretation. God inspired the writer's, so their message, were authentic and reliable. God used the talents, education, and cultural background of each writer (They were not mindless robots); and God cooperated with the writers in such a way, to ensure that the message that He intended was faithfully communicated in the very words they wrote. This process is known as *inspiration*. Again I say because this is an important point to make! The writers all wrote from their own personal, cultural, historical context. Although they used their own minds, talents, language, and style, they wrote only what God wanted them to write. Scripture is completely trust worthy because God was in control of its writing. Its words are entirely authoritative of our faith and lives. The Bible is "God-breathe!" So, we must read its teachings to guide our conduct. The Bible is our standard for living, and can test everything else that claims to be

It is a safeguard against false teaching, and our only true. real source of guidance. Also, it is the only source of knowledge about how we can be saved. God wants to show us what is true and equip us to live for Him. It is absolutely imperative, that we study the Bible regularly, if we want to discover God's Truth for us to help us become confident in our life and faith. Also, to be part of "God's Eternal Plan." We should not study God's Word simply to increase our knowledge or to prepare us to win theological arguments. We should study the Bible so that we will know how to do Christ's work in this sinful world we live. Our knowledge of God's Word is not useful unless it strengthens our faith, and leads all of us to do what is good. Many Christian speakers, teachers, and writers, talk about the pursuit of spiritual knowledge. But often they want power instead! Such people will not listen to "sound doctrine." Instead they turn their ears away from the truth and turn aside to myths. Through the eyes of the Holy Spirit, true believers can see this everywhere—from liberal churches to university campuses. People claiming, to have a bit more enlightenment, than what the Bible has to say; people claiming to improve on God's Words. Such people have several things in common. (1) They do not tolerate the truth. They have no interest or respect for God's absolute truths or any standard of judgment. (2) They reject truth for sensationalism. They want truth that fits their situation and makes sense to them. (3) *They gather viewpoints to* satisfy their own selfish desires. Although they profess objectivity, their only defense for their viewpoints is that those viewpoints satisfy and suit their desires. Such people have a following because they tell the people what their itching ears want to hear. Sad to say, but these people are following myths and false doctrine. Be careful and vigilant always! By being careful and vigilant, we will have a great opportunity, to defend ourselves against the false teachers and the devil at the same time. The real problem in today's society, is that approx only 7% truly pray and study the Bible daily. While the other approx 93% are too busy living for their flesh and not for God. It's no wonder why so many people fall prey to false teachings and false doctrine. Reason being, is that most people have only little to no substantial knowledge of the true Word of God. This is why so many false teachers and denominational religions are in such disarray. A majority of religious organizations out there today, are power brokers, and not brokers for the Lord. They love the control they have over approx 93%ers. However, they tend to stay far away from the 7% ers with all their lies and deceptions. Reason being, they fear that they will be exposed for their wicked deception. Also note that, some false teachers are just simply confused—they speak their misguided opinions without checking them against the Holy Bible.

Others have evil motives—they pretend to be Christians only because they can make more money ("dishonest gain"), additional business, or a feeling of power from being a leader of a church. Jesus and the apostles repeatedly warned against false teachers. It is written in Mark 13:5-6; Jesus said to them: "Watch out that no one deceives you. Many will come in My Name, claiming, I am He, and will deceive many. These false teachers have attacked, the foundation of truth and integrity upon which the Christian faith is built. How can we as believing Christians recognize false teachers? We can recognize false teachers because they will (1) focus more attention on themselves or false doctrines than on Christ; (2) ask you to do something that will compromise or dilute your faith; (3) deemphasize the divine nature of Christ or the inspiration of the Bible; or (4) urge believers to make decisions based more on human judgment than on prayer and biblical guidelines. So my brothers and sisters in the Lord Christ Jesus, we all have one choice to make. We can either continue to allow our eternal future to hang in the balance of the hands of divisive religious organizations, or we can find the truth firsthand. How can we find the truth firsthand about God? The Truth of the Lord can only be found by repentance of our sins, and making a sincere daily commitment to, prayer and Bible study. Once we repent and make a sincere commitment to daily prayer, and Bible study, just watch and see how God works His Spiritual magic! In time, He will Bless and share His Truth with you 24/7. After the point of conversion, spending time alone with God is the best way to develop a one on one personal relationship with Him. As Christians, we all need the Bibles view of God as high and lifted up, to empower us to deal with our problems and concerns. God's moral perfection properly seen and understood, will purify us from sin, cleanse our minds from our problems, and enable us to worship and to serve the Lord Christ Jesus. Also another important Truth; Please note that, the only true church according to the Bible, is one that is centered totally

on, God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit! Also, according to the Bible, nothing else can save us from eternal damnation except Jesus!! So my friends in the Lord Christ Jesus; please don't take my word for it!! Seek and find God's Truth for life on *your own!* How can we find out the truth for ourselves on our own? By sincere repentance, prayer, and daily Bible study. My brothers and sisters, we all owe it to our selves to find out God's Truth for living before leaving this planet. The Truth will set you free if you put your faith and trust in the Lord Jesus Christ Hallelujah... Amen!
