THE DAY OF THE LORD

This month's inspired message has to due with the day of the Lord. What do I mean when I say the day of the Lord? Because only the One who created the world, knows when the world will come to the end. The Holy Bible tells us in 2 Peter 3:10; But the day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar, the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything in it will be laid bare. The day of the Lord is the day of God's judgment upon the earth for the unrighteous and the righteous alike. This should be a picture of our trust----trading all our fears for faith in Jesus, no matter how intense our fears are! To do this we must "dwell" and rest with Him on a regular basis. When we entrust ourselves to His Protection and pledging our daily devotion to Him, we will be kept safe! The preparation for the Day of the Lord is based on faith. Without trust in the Lord, we don't have a chance. The Lord Jesus tells us in Psalm 37:3-5 to; Trust in the Lord and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture. Delight yourself in the Lord and He will give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the Lord; trust Him and do this. In order to escape the Wrath of God's eternal punishment on the day of His return to earth, we must be committed to Jesus! What does it mean to commit ourselves to the Lord? To commit ourselves to the Lord means entrusting everything----our lives, families, jobs, possessions to His control and guidance. The Holy Bible tells us in 1 Peter 5:7-9; Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that your brothers throughout the world are undergoing the same kind of sufferings. My brothers and sisters in the Lord, lions attack the sick, the young, or straggling animals; they choose victims who are alone or not alert. Apostle Paul warns us to watch out for Satan when we are suffering or being persecuted. If you are feeling alone or weak, helpless, and cut off from other believers, or if you are so focused on your troubles that you forget to watch for danger, those are the times when we are especially vulnerable to Satan's attacks. During times of suffering, seek other Christians for support. Keep your eyes on Christ, and resist the devil, then "he will flee from you"!! ANOTHER SPIRITUAL THOUGHT

Proverbs 13:24 tells us; [[He who spares the rod hates his son, but he who loves him is careful to discipline him.]] It is not easy for a loving parent to discipline a child, but it is necessary. The greatest responsibility that God gives parents is the nurture and guidance of their children.
