The story of the Birth of Christ is one of Divine intervention from God above. It is a story that goes back over 2000 years ago. According to the Bible, it started out with a women named Mary. And having been warned in a dream not to go back to Herod, they returned to their country by another route. Herod back in the days of the birth of Christ, was just another example of the hatred, and disrespect that most people have for Jesus Christ. Just look at the way people react in some parts of the world, when His name is mentioned. There are a lot of places in the world, where they will execute you if they think you are a part of the Lord's family. The greatest thing that this country has is our religious freedom; without it, we would not have Christmas.
