This month's important message has to do with helping us to distinguish the difference between being in this world, but not of this world. In Romans 12:2 it is written; Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's Will is—His good, pleasing and perfect will. God has good, pleasing, and perfect plans for all His children. He wants us all to be transformed people with renewed minds, that are living to honor and obey Him. Use the Bible to discover God's guidelines, and then follow them. In every perplexing situation ask yourself, "what would Jesus do?" *****

Have you ever worried about whether or not you really are a real Christian? A Christian is anyone who has the Spirit of God living in him or her! If you have sincerely trusted Christ for your salvation and acknowledge Him as Lord, then the Holy Spirit has come into your life, and you are a Christian. You won't know if the Holy Spirit has come if you are waiting for a certain feeling; you will know that has come because Jesus promised He would. There is great tension in daily Christian experience. The conflict is that as Christians we agree with God's commands but cannot do them. As a result, we are painfully aware of sin.

The Spirit of life is the Holy Spirit. He was present at the creation of the world. (Genesis 1:2), and He is the power behind the rebirth of every Christian. He gives us the power we need to live the Christian life.

So my friends, we should remain spiritually separated from the world's hatred and wickedness, even though we rub shoulders with unbelievers every day. It's no easy task to be holy in an unholy world, but God doesn't ask us to accomplish this on our own. He has provided help. Through the death of His Son Jesus, He will present us holy in His sight, without blemish and free from accusation. Colossians 1:21 tells us that because we were alienated from God, we were strangers to His way of thinking, and were enemies in our own minds.
