

In Christ's Kingdom, every born again believer is a priest. (1 Peter 2:9) The Christian's most powerful resource is communion with God through prayer. The results are often greater then we thought were possible. Some see prayer as a last resort when all else fails. others have grown a custom, This approach is backward. Prayer should come first, because God's way of dealing with our sins is far greater than man's. Clearly anyone who has wondered from the truth is a believer who has fallen into sin----one who is no longer living life consistent with God's Word. With all of God's promises and personal guarantees, He gives freely to all of those who stay on the road to Eternal Salvation. The victory and eternal prize, awaits, all who never give up on Christ Jesus. The Lord tells us in Psalm 145:17-18 The Lord is near to all who call on Him, to all who call on Him in truth. He fulfills the desires of those who fear Him; He hears their cry and saves them. My brothers and sisters in the Lord Christ Jesus, sometimes our burdens seem more than we can bear, and we wonder how we can go on another step. The evil voice in the back of our heads will do anything it can do, to pull you towards despair. Despair is a frame of mind you don't want to entertain in your mind not a minute.
