THE WORD OF GOD By Evangelist Dennis A. Palma

Dear Abba Father, Lord Jesus, and the Holy Spirit, we thank You, praise You, and bless You Lord, for another inspirational message this month. Father, please enlighten us to better understand the reality of Your Divine Truth. Lord, may our hearts and minds gravitate to Your Living Word, the Bible! Lord, please help us to avoid the pitfalls of secularism. Father, please help us to rise above Satan's forces of evil, that dominate this world. Lord Jesus, may Your Eternal Light cleanse this world of sin and darkness. Father, please teach us how to prepare our souls for the final victory in Christ Jesus. Lord, I ask this prayer in Jesus name. Hallelujah. Amen!

This month's inspired message from the Holy Spirit, has to do with God's Truth for living in a fallen world. This Truth for living in a fallen world can only be found in God's Living Word, the Bible. Most people hate to hear the word Bible! Others find freedom from the chains of bondage from sin. The Bible is not a collection of stories, fables, myths or merely human ideas about God. It is not a human book! Through God's Holy Spirit, the Lord revealed His person and plan to certain believers, who wrote down His inspired message for His people. It is written in 2 Peter 1:20, 21; Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation. For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit. "Men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit." This means that Scripture did not come from the prophet's own invention or interpretation. God inspired the writer's, so their message is authentic and reliable. God used the talents, education, and cultural background of each writer (They were not mindless robots); and God cooperated with the writers in such a way, to ensure that the message that He intended was faithfully communicated in the very words they wrote. This process is known as *inspiration*. Again I say because this is an important point to make, that the writers all wrote from their own personal, cultural, historical context. Although they used their own minds, talents, language, and style, they wrote only what God wanted them to write. The Bible is completely trust worthy because God is in control of its writing. Its words are entirely authoritative of our faith and lives. The Bible is "God-breathe!"

So, we must read its teachings to guide our conduct. The Bible is truly our standard for testing, everything else that claims to be true. It is a safeguard against false teaching and our source of guidance for how we should live. Also, it is the only source of knowledge about how we can be saved. God wants to show us what is true and equip us to live for Him. It is absolutely imperative, that we study the Bible daily, to discover God's Truth for us to become confident in our life and faith. Also, to be part of "God's Eternal *Plan.*" We should not study God's Word simply to increase our knowledge or to prepare us to win theological arguments. We should study the Bible so that we will know how to do Christ's work in this fallen world. Our knowledge of God's Word is not useful unless it strengthens our faith, and leads us to do what is good. Many Christian speakers, teachers, and writers talk about the pursuit of knowledge. But often they want power. Such people will not listen to "sound doctrine." Instead they turn their ears away from the truth and turn aside to myths. Through the eyes of the Holy Spirit, you can see this everywhere—from liberal churches to university campuses. People claiming, to have a bit more enlightenment, than what the Bible has to say; people claiming to improve on God's Words. Such people have several things in common. (1) *They do not tolerate the truth.* They have no interest or respect for God's absolute truths or any standard of judgment. (2) They reject truth for sensationalism. They want truth that fits their situation and makes sense to them. (3) They gather viewpoints to satisfy their own selfish *desires.* Although they profess objectivity, their only defense for their viewpoints is that those viewpoints satisfy and suit their desires. Such people have a following because they tell the people what their itching ears want to hear. These people are following myths and false doctrine. Be careful and vigilant always. By being careful and vigilant, we will have a great opportunity to defend ourselves against the false teachers and the devil at the same time. The real problem in today's society is that approx only 7% truly study the Bible daily. While the other approx 93% are too busy living for their flesh and not for God. It's no wonder why so many people fall prey to false teachings and false doctrine. Reason being is that, most people have little to no substantial knowledge of the Word of God. This is why so many false teachers and religions are in such disarray. A lot of religious organizations are power brokers. They love to control the majority of the members with their false doctrines. They tend to stay away from real born again believers with all their bad teaching, for fear they will be exposed!

However, some false teachers are simply confused—they speak their misguided opinions without checking them against the Bible. Some leaders have evil motives—they pretend to be real Christians as a means to make money ("dishonest gain"), additional business, or a feeling of power from being a leader of a large church. Jesus repeatedly warned His Apostles against false teachers. It is written in Mark 13:5-6; Jesus said to them: "Watch out that no one deceives you. Many will come in My Name, claiming, I am He, and will deceive many. These false teachers have attacked, the foundation of truth and integrity upon which the Christian faith is built upon. How can we as believing Christians recognize false teachers? We can recognize false teachers because they will (1) focus more attention on themselves or false doctrines than on Christ Jesus; (2)they will ask you to do something that will compromise or dilute your faith; (3) they will try to de-emphasize the divine nature of Christ or the inspiration of the Bible; or (4) Also, they will urge believers to make decisions based more on human judgment than on prayer and biblical guidelines with respect to God's Holy Trinity. So my brothers and sisters in the Lord Christ Jesus, we all have one choice to make. We can either continue to allow our eternal future to hang in the balance of the hands of divisive religious organizations. or we can find the truth firsthand. How can we find the truth firsthand about God? The Truth of the Lord can only be found by making a sincere daily commitment to, prayer and daily Bible study. Once we make a sincere commitment to daily prayer, and Bible study, just watch and see how God will Bless and share His Truth with you. After the point of conversion, spending time alone with God is the best way to develop a one on one personal relationship with Him. As Christians, we all need the Bibles view of God as high and lifted up, to empower us to deal with our problems and concerns. God's moral perfection properly seen, will purify us from sin, cleanse our minds from our problems, and enable us to worship and to serve. Also another important Truth, please note that the only true church according to the Holy Bible, is the one that is centered exclusively on, God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit! So my friends in the Lord, please don't take my word for it, go and find God's Truth on your own. Go to some place quiet and still, and ask God's Holy Spirit to help you read the Bible for yourself. Spiritually speaking, all Christians owe it to themselves to find out God's Truth for living a Godly life! Final thought: If you are getting tired of living in sin, guilt and darkness, and desire a fresh start, come to Christ Jesus. Also, try and remember that Jesus loves us all the same, and is anxiously waiting for a knock on His door! Come taste and see, the goodness of the Lord Jesus Christ, Amen!
