

When I say, we must live through the Spirit and not by the flesh, What am I trying to say? Living through the Holy Spirit, teaches us ways and means to stay focused on what God wants for us during this brief stay here on earth. Living by the flesh, demonstrates our dependence on ourselves and not on God. As we live by the Holy Spirit's power, we need to submit every aspect of our lives to God—emotional, physical, social, intellectual, vocational. God does not want only parts of us, He wants every aspect of our being. Living through the Spirit, involves the desire to hear the readiness, to obey God's word, and the sensitivity to discern between your feelings and His promptings. We must live each day controlled and guided by the Holy Spirit. Also, We must daily commit our sinful tendencies to God's control. Furthermore, moment by moment we must draw on the Holy Spirit's power to overcome evil. The Lord says in Galatians 2:20, I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The Holy Spirit is the source of our new life in Christ, so we must keep step in His leading. Furthermore, we must not let anything or anyone else determine our values and standards in any area of our life. The fruit of the Spirit is the spontaneous work of the Holy Spirit in us. The Spirit produces these character traits that are found in the nature of Christ. They are by-products of Christ control—we can't obtain them by trying to do them without His help. If we want the fruit of the Spirit to grow in us, we must join our lives to his. In John 15:4,5 it is written: Remain in Me, and I will remain in you, No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in Me.

Everyone of us, needs a certain amount of approval from others. But those who go out of their way to secure honors or to win popularity become conceited and show that they are not following the Holy Spirit's leading. Those who look for God's approval won't need to envy others. Because we are God's sons and daughters, we have God's Holy Spirit as a loving guarantee of His approval. Seek to please God, and the approval of others won't seem as important. As a believer, we are not left to our own resources to cope with problems. Even when we don't know the right words to pray, the Holy Spirit prays with and for us, and God answers. With God helping us to pray, we don't need to be afraid to come before Him. We need to ask the Holy Spirit to intercede for us "in accordance to God's Will." Then, when we bring our request to God, we can trust that He will always do what is best for us. The Holy Spirit is God's promise or guarantee of eternal life, for those who believe in Him! The Holy Spirit is in us, and by faith we are certain to live with Christ forever. The Lord says in John 16:13: But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you in all truth. He will not speak on His own; He will speak only what He hears, and He will tell vou what is vet to come.

Let's take a good look at this scripture and take a minute to reflect on what God is trying to say to us about His Holy Spirit. The truth into which the Holy Spirit guides us is the truth about Christ Jesus. The Holy Spirit also helps us, through patient practice, to discern right from wrong. Jesus said the Holy Spirit would tell them "what is yet to come"—the nature of their mission, the opposition they would face, and the final outcome of their efforts. They did not fully understand these promises until the Holy Spirit came after Jesus' death and resurrection. Then the Holy Spirit revealed truths to the disciples that they wrote down in the books that now form the New Testament. These same truths that inspired the disciples to write the New Testament, almost 2000 years ago, are the same truths that the Holy Spirit is revealing to all believing Christians today. These truths cannot be taken lightly, as that was then, and this is now! That kind of attitude is one of the biggest mistakes we can fall prey too, unless we have the Holy Spirit living within us, 24/7. It is also written in John 4:14: "But whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life." So my friends in the Lord Christ Jesus, it is very clear according to God's Holy Bible, that in order to maintain any real peace and understanding in our lives, we must have the Holy Spirit dwelling from inside our souls. The world and our flesh will always eventually bring us down to a place of hell spiritually, if we don't trust and believe in God's Holy Spirit.

Try and always remember, in fact write this down and keep it with you daily! Sin, fear, uncertainty, doubt, and numerous other forces are at war within us. But when we have the indwelling of the Holt Spirit, the peace of God moves into our hearts and lives to restrain these hostile forces and offers <u>comfort in place of conflict!</u> (John 14:27)

Let us pray. Lord may we again keep giving You thanks, praise, and blessings for everything You have done for Your people. Lord, please continue to give us Your daily strength, to fight off the unknown forces that surround us. Help us Lord, to fight the good fight to overcome the evils of this world. Lord please carry us through this evil fallen world of hatred, violence, corruption, etc. Lord protect us from the evil one. Father, I ask this prayer in Jesus name,... Hallelujah Amen.
