This months inspired message has to do with a sin that has corrupted and devastated our world throughout history. This sin is the sin of greed! Greed has started more wars throughout the world and has corrupted more people, than any other sin in the world today. As I take a good look at the troubled economic outlook of the world today, it is real easy to see all the corruption and mayhem that has directly stemmed from greed. There is so much hunger and starvation around the world from greed, that it really makes you sick in your stomach when you really think about it. There is a great story in the Bible about greed, where God is trying to teach us all about the eventual spiritual destruction that can come from greed. Jesus tells about the Rich Man and the Beggar. The story begins in Luke 16:19: "There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and lived in luxury everyday. At the gate laid a beggar name Lazarus, covered with sores and longing to eat what fell from the rich man's table. Even the dogs came and licked his sores. The time came when the beggar died and the angels carried him to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried, in hell, where he was in torment, he looked and saw Abraham far away with Lazarus by his side. So he called to him, Father Abraham, have pity on me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, because I am in agony in this fire. "But Abraham replied, Son remember that in your lifetime you received

your good things, while Lazarus received bad things, but now he is comforted here and you are in agony. And besides all this, between us and you a great chasm has been fixed, so that those who want to go from here to you cannot, nor can anyone cross over from there to us. "He answered, Then I beg you, father, send Lazarus to my father's house, for I have five brothers. Let him warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment. "Abraham replied, he said, They have Moses and the Prophets; let them listen to them. No Father Abraham, he said, but if someone from the dead goes to tell them, they will repent.

He said to him, if they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead.

In this story, God's urgent message, is to help us refrain from all our personnel egoism, pride, and selfishness that lurks from within all of us. By being conscious of God's warning about greed, is just another way He demonstrates His concern and love for all of us.

Our use of money is a good test of the lordship of Christ. (1) Money belongs to God, not us; let us use our resources wisely. (2) Money can be used for good or evil; let us use ours for good. (3) Money has a lot of power; let us use it carefully and thoughtfully. We must use our material goods in a way that will foster faith and obedience. We are to make wise use of the financial opportunities we have, not to earn heaven, so that heaven (" eternal dwellings") will be a welcome experience for those we help.

If we use our money to help others find Christ, our earthly investment will bring eternal benefit. When we obey God's will, the unselfish use of possessions will follow. Our integrity often meets it's match in money matters. God calls us to be honest even in small details we can easily rationalize away. Heavens riches are far more valuable than earthly wealth. But if we are not trustworthy with our money here (no matter how much or little we have), we will be unfit to handle the vast riches of God's kingdom. Don't let your integrity slip in small matters, and it will not fail you in crucial decisions either.

Money can easily take God's place in your life. I can become your master. How can you tell if you are a slave to money? Ask yourself: Do I think and worry about money frequently? Do I give up doing what I should do or would like to do in order to make more money? Do I spend a great deal of time caring for my possessions? Is it hard for me to give money away? Am I in debt?

Money is a hard and deceptive master. Wealth promises power and control, but often it cannot deliver. Great fortunes can be made—and lost overnight, and no amount of money can provide health, happiness, or eternal life. How much better is it to let God be your Master. His servants have peace of mind and security, both now and forever! So my brothers and sisters in the Lord Jesus Christ, may we all embrace this message with a sense of understanding and wisdom. Lets us all pray that the devil's deceptive and destructive trap is altered, by God's Eternal Plan. Let us pray. Father we come to You at this time of need, for Your Holy Spirit to guide us, direct us, and protect us from Satin's controlling grip. May we use Your money Lord, wisely and generously with a spirit of selflessness. Father, give us the strength to fight the temptations of greed.
